

## The Triptych of Your Dreams

A **triptych** is a work of art that is in three separate pieces, but meant to be appreciated all together. **Angelica Muro**, an artist from our current **Califas Legacy Project** exhibition uses this technique in her triptych **Agricultural Workers in Gucci**. Separating your art into pieces can sometimes help tell your story. What is something you dream about? For this project, imagine three dreams you have for your future!

### MATERIALS

- Two (2) pieces of Paper
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Black pen
- Markers or watercolors
- Scissors
- Glue

### STEP ONE

**Measure and cut** a piece of paper into 3 equal parts.

On each paper, **sketch** something that you dream about for your future.

Use a black pen or marker to **trace** over your lines.

### STEP TWO

On a larger sheet of paper, **glue** your 3 dreams, leaving some space between each paper.

**Add colorful frames** around your dreams, and anything that will make you happy when you look at your dreams!
