MATERIALS

- Paintbrush

- Paper towel
- Watercolor or other sturdy paper



Cosmic Doodle

In this project you'll make a beautiful pattern of bright colors after you've scribbled a line. Did you know that a line is a dot that went for a walk? Don't take long on your doodle, just a few moments.

STEP ONE

Using your pen or pencil, make a loopy line all around your watercolor paper.

STEP TWO

Don't take too long, just start your line and see where it takes you. See if you can go all over your page - up and down, left and right. This part takes under a minute!

STEP THREE

Now choose a color and fill in a section created by your doodling line.



STEP FOUR

Now choose another color, and fill in the next section.

STEP FIVE

Change your color as often as you like, and keep going until your whole loopy Cosmic Doodle is filled with beautiful colors.

STEP SIX

If that was fun, make another one!
