Paper Spider Webs : Kirigami

Kirigami is a variation of origami that includes cutting paper, rather than solely folding paper as in origami. The project builds on the exploration of holiday traditions and paper media techniques.

1



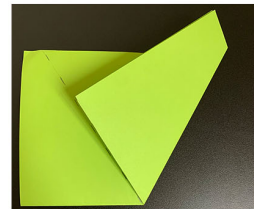
Take a regular sheet of colored paper and fold it in 1/2, bottom to top.

2



Fold the paper in 1/2 and make a crease so you can see the half way mark.

3



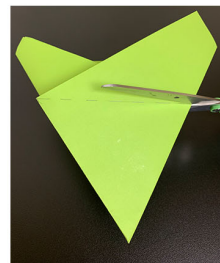
Fold the right side of the paper towards the left, into thirds. Repeat on the other side. Left flap goes inside the larger right flap.

4



Use the edge of a plate to draw a curved line at the widest pt in the cone.

5



Use a pair of scissors to cut the paper on the top curved line.
